NSFA Representative Program Policy

NSFA operates and participates in a number of Representative Programs with the aim of developing local players to the level of National Premier League and beyond.

The NSFA policy on the selection of participants in NSFA Representative Programs is as follows:

NSFA Football School – preference will be given to candidates who are a resident within the NSFA Boundaries* or are registered with an NSFA club in that season.

FNSW Association Youth League (AYL) – as per the FNSW competition rules.

FNSW Skill Acquisition Program – as per the FNSW competition rules.

FNSW Metro Far North State Titles – as per the FNSW Competition rules.

Northern Tigers (U13-U18) – preference be given to “NSFA Players” over non “NSFA players” when players are of a similar ability.

“NSFA Players” is defined as:

- a) Northern Tigers player in previous season; or
- b) Played with NSFA club in previous year; or
- c) Resident within NSFA Boundaries.

Any vacancies may then be filled by players who are not “NSFA Players” as defined above.

Coaching Development Courses – Coaching Development Courses are conducted by NSFA under the auspices of FFA and FNSW. Preference will be given to candidates from NSFA clubs but where the minimum number of candidates falls short of the number required to conduct the course places may be offered to candidates from outside the NSFA membership.
