COACH PLEDGE

Please make yourself familiar with the code as it applies to you as a coach

- I will remember that players participate for enjoyment and winning is only part of the fun.
- I will never ridicule or yell at a youth player for making a mistake or not winning.
- I will be reasonable in my demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- I will operate within the laws and spirit of the game, and teach the players to do the same.
- I will ensure that the time players spend with me is a positive experience.
- I will not use offensive language around youth players.
- I will not harass players, match officials, coaches or spectators.
- I will not participate in public arguments with players, coaches, parents, spectators.
- I understand that any abuse of match officials is not acceptable or permitted behaviours.
- I will not argue with or approach a match official during or after a match.
- I will ensure the players safety is a priority at all times.
- I will display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport including all players, match officials, coaches, club officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. I will encourage players to do the same.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability and cultural background.
- I will not smoke, drink alcohol, take illicit drugs at matches and training, or arrive at the field intoxicated or under the influence of illicit drugs.
- I will obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up to date with the latest coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young players.
- I will comply with the Northern Tigers FC/NSFA Football Plan and Philosophy.
- I will fulfill the Football NSW and/or FFA mandatory Child Protection requirements.
- I will not engage in social media, forums or blogs to comment on NSFA/Northern Tigers or opposition clubs (includes teams, players, coaches, match officials, club officials, parents or spectators).

I agree to abide by this code of conduct and to be subject to the rules and policies of the Northern Suburbs Football Association (NSFA) and Northern Tigers Football Club.

If I breach the above code of conduct, I understand NSFA/Northern Tigers FC may impose a penalty ranging from a written warning to immediate de-registration.
